RWY 32 has an uphill incline of 46 ft. (RWY 14, thus, downhill 46 ft.) Recommended approach (unless there is significant tailwind) is RWY 32, Remaining runway length markers every 500 ft. Recommended departure (unless there is significant tailwind) is RWY 14. Prevailing winds favor RWY 32. Wind sock and VLS is located on approach end of RWY 32. Gear retraction prior to clearing end of runway on approach and departure may increase risk of prop strike. Pilots assume all risk associated with landing at or departing from Mountain Air Airport. Report any safety issues to MAPOA and/or Pro-Shop immediately.
